## **Annual Report for 2024-2025**

It is with great pride that I present the Annual Report of ABPS, Khor for the academic year 2024-2025. This year, we've experienced countless moments of achievement and growth, reflecting the commitment and hard work of our students, faculty and staff.

### **Academic Excellence and Achievements**

As we reflect on the academic year, we celebrate the remarkable achievements of our students. The year began with the Flag Assembly on April 1, 2024, setting the stage for a year filled with enthusiasm and academic excellence. Our Board results were 100%. Master Bhumik Kumar Vishwakarma topped the SSCE in Science Stream with an outstanding 93.6% and cleared NEET in the first attempt. Miss Mahak Khanam topped the Commerce Stream with 92.2%. We also celebrate the perfect centum in Informatics Practices by Mayank Sharma.

In the Grade 10 Board Exams, Toshita Goyal secured 96.6%, Shrasti Mallik 95.8%, and Pratheesha earned 95.4%. Additionally, six of our students attained a perfect centum in Sanskrit, demonstrating outstanding performance in diverse subjects.

### **Fostering Holistic Growth**

At ABPS Khor, we believe in nurturing not only academic talent but also character and values. Our commitment to holistic development is reflected in the array of co-curricular activities we offer.

This year, students participated in numerous state and national events, enhancing their understanding of global perspectives. We celebrated Yoga Day, Earth Day, World Environment Day, Mental Health Day and Constitution Day, which emphasized mindfulness, environmental responsibility, and community engagement. Special events like Swami Vivekananda's birthday, Constitution Day, Children's Day and Alumni Reunion, Doctors Day, joint celebration of Republic Day and Independence Day and Teacher's Day were celebrated with zeal, fostering a sense of national pride and respect for our educators.

The Prefectorial Board, chosen during the Investiture Ceremony and led by Master Atharv Sharma and Ms. Arya Raj Tiwari, displayed exemplary leadership throughout the year. Their efforts in guiding and mentoring their peers have contributed greatly to maintaining discipline and promoting a culture of service within the school.

### **Infrastructural and Technological Advancements**

Our continuous progress would not have been possible without the vision and support of our Management and guidance of our CEO, whose strategic direction and unwavering commitment to excellence have played a pivotal role in our achievements. This year, our school has made significant strides in enhancing its infrastructure, ensuring an environment conducive to learning. New Tata Edge Smart Boards were added, and library facilities were enhanced to provide our students with the latest resources. The addition of STEM Lab in July 2024 has been a significant milestone, providing a hands-on learning space that encourages creativity and innovation in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.

In our pursuit of skill-based education, we introduced new subjects designed to equip students with practical knowledge for the future. Furthermore, the successful implementation of our ERP system

has enhanced communication and collaboration between parents, students, and the school administration, fostering a more connected and informed school community.

### **Co-Curricular Achievements and Innovative Initiatives**

The academic success of our students was complemented by their outstanding performance in co-curricular and inter-school competitions. ABPS, Khor conducted the ABG Photography Competition Lens and Light and participated in various ABG Inter-School Competitions. Our students were shortlisted for the “Young Minds” AD Challenge, STEM Quest Science Challenge, Senior Group English Debate, and English One-Act Play. It gives me immense pride in announcing that our junior team secured first place in the "Code Quest" Inter-School Coding Competition, creating an innovative mobile app to assist the visually impaired.

In athletics, our students showcased remarkable prowess at the Athletics Cluster XII event, where Atharv Jhanwar secured a bronze medal in the 5000m race and Rajveer Singh Sankhla earned a bronze in the 100m sprint. These achievements reflect our school’s dedication to nurturing physical fitness and a competitive spirit among our students.

Our students have once again demonstrated their excellence in sports. At the State-Level Taekwondo Championship, Divya Yadav, Aasha Dhakad, and Devvrat Singh each secured silver medals, qualifying for the Nationals. In Badminton, Reet Mittal excelled in the Under-11 and Under-13 categories, while Darshil Agrawal and Harshal Jaiswal triumphed in the Under-15 category.

### **Science & Innovation**

Beyond sports, we also made significant strides in science and innovation. Archit Singh Rathore from X B presented his home automation project using Google Assistant at the National Level GMRT Science Exhibition, while Aadhy Jain and Parv Mittal from IX A introduced an innovative model for waste management—a smart dustbin designed to automate the segregation of wet and dry waste was selected for CBSE Science Exhibition held at Indore. This project, which simplifies waste disposal and promotes hygiene, highlights the students' ability to address real-world challenges through innovation.

### **Outreach Programme**

This year, ABPS Khor hosted various programs aimed at enhancing learning and personal development. Our Summer Camp offered children a platform to engage in creative and interactive activities, fostering a love for learning. The IISER Summer Camp in Bhopal and the Astronomy Quiz organized by the Aryabhat Foundation sparked curiosity and passion for discovery. Our students also participated in the CBSE Science and Reading Challenges, further enhancing their knowledge and skills in a wide range of subjects.

At ABPS Khor, we believe that education is not just about academic growth but also about nurturing values and global perspectives. Initiatives like the Sanrakshan plantation drive and Bhartiya Sanskriti Gyan Pariksha emphasized environmental stewardship and cultural heritage. Clubs for art, Circle time, debate, MUN and conservation added vibrancy to the campus, allowing students to explore and excel.

### **Workshops and Counselling**

Workshops and counselling sessions have been instrumental in fostering the holistic development of our students. Programs like “MindForge,” *Manthan*, and various sessions conducted by the Aditya Birla Group (ABG) emphasized innovative teaching methodologies and quality standards.

Additionally, in-house workshops led by our dedicated teachers and their teams focused on SQAA, teaching techniques, and pedagogical approaches, providing valuable opportunities to refine and enhance their classroom strategies. Teachers also attended Physical workshops at Adityapuram on Experiential Curriculum at Foundational Level, Pedagogy at Nagda and Strong Foundations at Mumbai. The workshops Abhivridhi and Principals Conclave focussed on strengthening School operations and Changing landscape in education.

Our career counselling workshop, led by Dr. Mukul Bindra, the health and hygiene workshop conducted by Dr. Priti Anand from Vikram Jan Sewa Trust and Dr. Swati Wadhwa on Mental Health, have played a vital role in supporting students' physical, emotional well-being, and future preparedness.

We introduced the Minds Matter Curriculum for classes I to XII this year and the workshops led by Mr Ramdev Galanga with his team promoted mental health and resilience, helping students manage academic and personal challenges.
