EXCELLENCE IN ACADEMICS

NEW ACADEMIC SESSION 2024-2025

New session commenced on the first working day of April 2024. At present, there are 1203 students on roll with 44 Teachers, 5 Administrative staff and 17 Supporting staff.

SUPPORT & GUIDANCE TO CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

At ABPS, our approach is centred around the belief that play is an indispensable aspect of the learning process. We maintain a child-centric system coupled with inclusive education, aiming to prepare students for life beyond school. The entire team of administrative, teaching & non-teaching staff whole heartedly support children with Special Needs.

- We have provision of counselling services at personal level for CWSN parents.
- IEP, Individualised Education Plan is prepared for academic, behavioural, and social needs for CWSN students.
- Our CWSN students participated in school exhibition.

SERVICE LEARNING & SOCIAL OUTREACH:

Our students visited a tribal school run by Samanvaya Parivar Samiti, founded by Swami Mitranandji, spending quality time with the children and distribution of stationery items among ashram children.

SANRAKSHAN: A CONTINUOUS PROCESS

Our students are the Drivers of Sanrakshan spreading awareness for conservation of environment. Trees were planted under the GO GREEN Project. Students reused plastic bottles, recycled paper, repurpose waste and created awareness via street plays and campaigns.

STEM LAB:

STEM LAB has been set up in our school, creating opportunities for our students to engage in hands-on science activities with practical experiments and demonstrations cultivating a genuine passion for science. Eight of our teachers are trained to facilitate students and their experiments. Students participated in a four-day Accelerator Workshop conducted by talented resource people where our students got the chance to explore and experiment independently and prepare Prototypes: Protonix; Voice enabled wheel chair for especially abled person; Mediwatch (Recovering from Addiction) and Smart Sensor which helps Pregnant women. We are thankful to our school management for their great support in setting up the STEM Lab.

ABG BRAND BOOK:

ABG Brand Book released by the Central Team, Delhi is followed religiously to maintain uniformity among all the ABG schools.

ZOHO COMMUNICATION:

The central Team, Delhi has created unique email Ids of each employee of all ABG schools for data privacy and smooth communication.

FOUNDATION GROUP: EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

After long brain storming, the resource people from central team have designed Aditya Experiential Curriculum, which is aligned with NCF. Two of our teachers attended a workshop 'ANUBHAV' at Chittorgarh, wherein the concept of experiential learning was discussed among teachers. We have been implementing the content received from the central team since Sept 2024. Teachers now are engaged with students in activities conducted in the classroom-Circle Time, Rhymes and Story Time.

INTRODUCTION OF SKILL SUBJECTS

Introduction of skill subjects in classes III to XII from the session 2024-25 aimed to equip students with practical skills and enhance their overall learning experience. By incorporating skill subjects, we facilitate our students to gain hands-on experience and develop expertise in areas that align with their interests and future career paths.

ERP-INTEGRATED E-GOVERNANCE PLATFORM

Effective communication between the school and parents ensure that the students' academic, co-curricular and personal development is scaffold best. The school has taken to ERP system on the school website with the view to communicate the progress of students to parents in a manner, which is eco-friendly, prompt and can be saved for reference. We are using ERP software system which automates the daily activity such as curriculum tracking, test, worksheets, official circulars and attendance. All teachers were facilitated with the sufficient information in a workshop. ERP software connects the parents, teachers, principal and management at same platform.

EXTRA MARKS CAREER COUNSELLING:

Career Assessment Program, specially designed for students of class IX to XII has been introduced by the central team, Delhi. CAP helps students choose the most suitable career path and take an informed decision based on their unique strengths and weakness. Students attended career counselling session. Our students as well as parents took the CAP TEST.

CACA PROJECT

The implementation of Project CACA, Children Against Child Abuse in classes UKG to IX aims to keep our children Happy, Healthy and Safe. The core instrument of the Project, 'The CACA Safety Workbooks are implemented for the students. Before the implementation of the Project, teachers, Admin staff and the non-teaching staff attended Integrated webinar that covered child related laws like POCSO and JJAct the required behavioural changes among stakeholders to prevent child abuse.

EXTERNAL COMPETITIONS SUGGESTED BY CENTRAL TEAM**TERI**

The Green Olympiad on environment initiated by the energy and resource institute (TERI) was held in the school for educating our students about Sustainable Development Goals. This unique interdisciplinary programme strengthens environmental conscious behaviour and attitude of students.

JHANKRITI 2024

Jhankriti offers a distinctive platform for budding artists, performers, and culture enthusiasts worldwide to display their talents and traditions. Our students participated in Mono acting, solo song, group song, solo dance, group dance, tabla and flute held at national level. A few students were semi-finalist at the Jhankriti competition. WORKSHOPS/TRAINING ATTENDED BY TEACHERS

A great teacher is important to student achievement. To ensure that all our students want to have a joyful learning under the guidance of successful teachers, ABMCPL encourages special training for our facilitators.

CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME:

ABPS, Renukoot fraternity is dedicated to enabling each child to reach their full potential, guided by the principles of transparency, trust, and continual learning. Participation of Teachers in online and offline training program organised by OUP, ABEA and CBSE. Our 13 teachers participated in offline workshops held at ABPS Nagda, ABPS RAWAN, ABPS, Adityapuram Chittorgarh, ABHSS Nagda, ABPS Kumarpattnam, ABPS Baikunth, ABPS Sidhi, ABPS Kotputli and Gyanodaya Mumbai. Mr Vivekanand has been attending a yearlong online Global Education since August 2024.

Our school was the district level coordinator for the conduct of the Parakh Rashtriya Sarvekshan 2024, one of the largest nationwide sample-based education surveys for the entire Sonebhadra district.

INDUCTION PROGRAM FOR NEW JOINERS OF SHSS, MAIHAR

We are dynamic educational institution dedicated to fostering academic excellence and character development. Our school was selected to hold induction program of two days for new joiners of Sarla Higher Secondary School, Maihar to understand our vibrant school system.

CHANGES AND DEVELOPMENT:

The session 2023-24 witnessed great changes and revamping for a better appearance and smooth functioning of the school. Installation of 65-inch TV in the principal's office has enhanced CCTV viewing. CCTV Network has been upgraded from Cat 6 cables to optical fiber cables, ensuring improved surveillance quality and reliability. Junior and senior Computer Lab are furnished with wall panelling and false ceiling work to improve the learning environment. A STEM Lab Constructed with state-of-the-art equipment and modern furniture to support hands-on learning in science and technology. Seven new air conditioning units have been installed in Physics Lab, Biology Lab, STEM Lab and the School Library. The out-dated furniture has been replaced with new modern and functional set ups in all labs and for Heads of Departments with updated and ergonomic setups. The light poles have been installed in the volleyball court for extended usability during evening hours. Old Venetian blinds with new, updated blinds in the school library for better functionality and aesthetics. I personally thank the management for providing the infrastructure and for their constant support and encouragement.

SAFETY AND SECURITY

Evacuation Plan is displayed at the entrance and various locations. Power point presentation of evacuation plan during emergency was presented in the morning assembly. Mock drill for safe evacuation was conducted in the school. First Aid for teachers was conducted to train teachers about the first aid to be given to students when required. Fire Safety precautions were demonstrated in the school by the fire and safety department of Hindalco industries. IT department of Hindalco Industries conducted cyber security session for our students.

GYANODAYA

A four day workshop for all the Principals of Aditya Birla Group School was organized at Mumbai to discuss various issues and planning for its remedies along with the action plan. I was active participant of the same from 3rd December to 6th December, 2024.

TRAINING IN LEADERSHIP SKILL

Our students created Web designing HTML projects namely Future of Nuclear Technology and ABPS-Future of Education, which were much appreciated. School Exhibition was a learning experience and a way to evaluate academic progress of our students.
