Academic Achievements:

Outstanding board results for the Class X and XII session 2023-24! Ms. Priyanka Bora excelled with an impressive 93.60% in the Commerce Stream of Std. XII, whereas Master Dilkhush Jangid secured the top position in the XII Science Stream with a stellar 84.40%. Here we were in the 6th position in 23 Aditya Birla Group Schools.

Our school proudly claimed the 8th rank among the 27 Aditya Birla Group of Schools in class X. Notably, Master Mayur Wavankar topped the school by securing a remarkable 96.40% whereas Master Dhruv Nigam secured 96% and Master Yatharth Pareek achieved 95.8 %.

To enhance subject knowledge and to improve performance of students, subject specific classes (Remedial & Enrichment) are conducted from Monday to Friday every week.
