

## Synopsis of the academic and non-scholastic excellence of ABPS, Kovaya :

The academic year 2024–25 has been a remarkable journey of growth, innovation, and holistic excellence at ABPS, Kovaya. Guided by the visionary ideals of the Aditya Birla Group, our school has continued its unwavering commitment to nurturing intellectual curiosity, emotional intelligence, and ethical leadership. This year has been a celebration of knowledge, creativity, and community spirit — a year that truly embodied our motto and dictum – That which liberate is knowledge, holistic development and Learning for Life.

### Academic Excellence & Innovation –

ABPS, Kovaya has produced very envious **academic result** for the year 2024-25 amidst the Aditya Birla Group of schools. All in all, 64 students appeared in the CBSE- CLASS-X. All 64 students passed the exam with 100 % Quantitative Result as well as 78.54% Qualitative Result. Miss Shubhangi Sharma secured 1<sup>st</sup> position by scoring 97%. So far Class – XII – Science & Commerce Streams are concerned, 58 students appeared in the exam with 100% Quantitative Result as well as 79.6% Qualitative Result. Miss Suhani Sharma secured 1<sup>st</sup> position by scoring 95.8. Miss Khushali Bhola has secured first position in the faculty of Commerce by securing 93.8%.



The year began with a renewed focus on academic transparency and interdisciplinary learning. A transformative initiative replaced the conventional system of report card distribution with Parent-Teacher Interaction Sessions, where teachers personally reviewed answer sheets with students and parents. This thoughtful approach strengthened home-school collaboration and was widely appreciated for promoting reflective learning and constructive dialogue. A milestone achievement was the inauguration of the state-of-the-art **STEM Laboratory** by Mr. Sambhav Shrivastav, Unit Head, GCW. This modern facility integrates Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, and AI, empowering students to develop problem-solving abilities and 21st-century competencies. To



unlock its full potential, an Accelerator Workshop trained students to apply design thinking and innovation to real-world challenges.



### **Fostering Well-being through Yoga & Community Engagement and Leadership**

The 11th **International Yoga Day**, themed ‘One Earth, One Health’, was celebrated with spiritual fervor. The event began with the ceremonial lamp-lighting, followed by mesmerizing Yoga Pledge and Dance presentations — *Shiv Tandav Stotra* by boys and *Ganesh Vandana* by girls — blending physical postures with divine rhythm. A mass Surya Namaskar and Yoga Quiz were the prime attractions. The **Investiture Ceremony** was a proud moment as the newly appointed Student Council members — Head Boy, Head Girl, House Captains, and Prefects — pledged to uphold the school’s values and lead with integrity.
