



# ADITYA BIRLA INTERMEDIATE COLLEGE, RENUSAGAR

## Annual Report-2025-26

This school was established in 1968, marking an important beginning in providing quality education in the region. With continuous improvement in academic standards and an increase in the number of students, the school was upgraded to a Higher School in 1977, enabling it to provide education up to Class 10.

Progressing further with time, the institution achieved another significant milestone in 1991 when it was granted the status of an Intermediate College. After this upgrade, the school started offering education for Classes 11 and 12 in all three streams—Science, Commerce, and Arts—thereby becoming a major educational center in the region.

The board examination results of the school have been highly commendable. This year, the overall pass percentage at the state level for Class 10 was around 90%, whereas our school achieved an impressive pass percentage of about 98%.

A total of 146 students appeared for the Class 10 examination, out of which 102 students secured First Division. Navya Singh secured the first position in the school with 88.20% marks.

The Class 12 examination result was 100%. Out of 96 students, 69 students passed with First Division. Sakshi Thakur secured the first position with 82% marks.

Among all A.B.G. State Board Schools, our school secured the 10<sup>th</sup> position in Class 10 results and the 3<sup>rd</sup> position in Class 12 results. In the Class 12 board examination, 9 out of the top 10 positions were secured by girls, and similarly, in Class 10, girls secured 9 out of the top 10 positions.

A successful **summer camp named “Udaan”** was organized in the school from 9 June to 21 June. During this camp, students were trained in music, yoga, pottery, painting, and other creative activities. The school also successfully organized events such as International Women’s Day, Fire Safety Week, various quizzes and competitions, and a large rally based on the theme of a Tobacco-Free India.

## **Achievements in Sports**

### **1. National Level Achievement**

Master Suraj Kumar Dubey (Class XI) qualified for the National Level Kho-Kho Competition and participated in the national event held in Gwalior on 26–27 September. His team, representing Uttar Pradesh, won the Gold Medal.

### **2. State Level Achievement (Swimming Competition)**

**Master Suresh Vishwakarma** won a Silver Medal in the 4×100 Medley Relay, while **Master Mukesh Vishwakarma** secured a Bronze Medal in the 4×100 Meter Freestyle Relay Race. Both students had earlier won Gold Medals in previous rounds and qualified for the state-level competition.

### **3. Qualified for State Level (Chess Competition)**

Two of our students, **Apoorva Jaiswal and Deepesh Kumar**, qualified for the state level. Earlier, they were winners at the district and divisional levels, after which they became eligible for the state-level chess competition.

### **4. Qualified for State Level (Yoga Competition)**

From the school, 11 students secured first place at the district level. After that, they went to Chunar, Mirzapur to participate at the divisional level, where all the students won Gold Medals, earning the school the opportunity to participate in the state-level competition.

### **5. District Level Competition (Running Event)**

Two of our students, **Master Badal** and **Master Yuvraj**, participated in the District Level Athletics Competition held in Madhupur on 16 October 2025. In the 100-meter race, Master Badal secured second position at the district level.

### **6. District Level Girls' Football Competition**

For the first time, our girls' football team participated in the district-level football championship and won their first match 1–0, qualifying for the semi-finals. **Ms. Anjali Pandey** was declared the **Best Player of the Match**.

In the match held at Obra, our team defeated GGIC Dudhi by 1–0 and entered the semi-finals.

The Chief Guest, Ms. Nisha Singh, Chairperson of Nagar Panchayat Renukoot, awarded the team a cash prize of ₹1600.

Ms. Anjali Pandey was declared the Best Player of the Match.

The team received proper guidance from Mr. B. L. Pathak and Mrs. Indu Singh.

## **Achievements in Kala Utsav (A state level competition)**

### **1. State Level Achievement (Art Competition)**

Kala Utsav is a highly prestigious competition organized by the Government of Uttar Pradesh. Initially, our school participated at the district level in five categories:

- Solo Dance
- Solo Singing
- Sculpture
- Skit
- Painting

**Except for Solo Dance**, our school was selected for the divisional level competition in Chunar in all other categories. At Chunar, our school secured first place in Skit and Sculpture, qualifying for the state level.

The state-level competition was held in Prayagraj, where:

- Ms. Soumya Pandey and Master Om Pandey **secured third place in the Skit Competition.**
- Master Ashutosh Kumar Srivastava **secured fifth place in the Sculpture Competition.**

### **2. Achievement in Hindi Debate Competition**

#### **1. Qualified for State Level (Debate Competition)**

The Hindi Debate Competition (Dr. Sampurnanand Hindi Debate Competition) was held in Robertsganj on 16 October 2025. Top schools of the district participated in this prestigious event.

Despite strong competition, our school secured first place and qualified for the divisional level.

Later, on 15 November 2025, our team participated in the divisional-level competition held in Mirzapur and once again secured first place.

In this competition:

- Ms. Soumya Pandey spoke for the motion,

- Ms. Saziya spoke against the motion, both performing excellently. With this achievement, the school has qualified for the state-level debate competition. The students were guided by Dr. Veena Pani, Head of the Hindi Department.

### 3. **Qualified for Division Level (Debate Competition)**

In the district-level debate competition held in Robertsganj on 29 October 2025, two students from ABIC — **Ms. Shreya Shukla and Ms. Gauri Gupta** participated.

Both students from ABIC, Renusagar secured first place in their respective categories:

- For the motion
- Against the motion

With this achievement, they were selected for the divisional level. Their preparation was guided by Dr. Veena Pani, Head of the Hindi Department.

### 4. **Qualified for State Level (Painting Competition)**

The District Level Painting Competition was organized by the State Government in Robertsganj in the month of September on the occasion of Swachhata Pakhwada.

A prize amount of ₹25,000 was announced for the district-level winner, along with qualification for the state-level competition.

Representing the school in the open category, Art Teacher Mr. Arvind Tiwari participated and secured first place.

ABIC Renusagar secured second place in the ABG Cinespark (Short Film) Competition. This is a remarkable achievement.
