Our new initiatives and Highlights (2024-25)

- School was converted into single shift to cater to the needs of the children as per School Development Plan and Annual Pedagogical Plan for ABG Schools (**framed as per NCF and NEP**) which recommends minimum $4\frac{1}{2}$ hrs to $5\frac{1}{2}$ hrs for Foundational group children. In 2024-25, we could provide 4 hrs of schooling to LKG & UKG children as compared to previous years when only 2 hours of school time was possible for LKG & UKG. We have planned for 5 hrs of schooling for foundational group in 2025-26.

As a result of this initiative, the school got the following advantages:

- School is now able to run with the existing number of teachers in this session and there are advantages in Logistic Expenses.
- No merging of classes required during Govt. notifications (extreme climatic conditions as notified by govt. twice every year) which creates lot of confusion in School routine.
- Availability of all the teachers and children before any program or celebration for rehearsal or participation.
- Availability of the supporting staff during entire school hours which was not possible during double shift.
- Availability of all the teachers during conduction of any enrichment program.
- Smooth conduction of examination in single shift.
- Logbook format introduced for checking the digital content usage by teachers through smart board has been introduced.
- This year we have successfully declared result through Entab and also distributed Holistic Report Cards.
