1. I would like to begin with ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE:

The school follows the trimester curriculum framed by the Government of Tamil Nadu. The assessment method is 60% SA and 40% FA for classes 1 to 7 and a non-semester pattern for classes 8 to 10.

Board Examination 2023-24:

Our school achieved excellent results in Class X Board examination in the academic year 2023-24. A total of 34 students appeared, and the results are as follows:

13 students scored above 90%

14 students scored between 80-89%

4 students scored between 70-79%

2 students scored between 60-69%

1 student scored above 50%

Total distinctions were 29 out of 34.

We are proud to announce that Ms. S. Soundarya is the school topper with 98.4% and she is the **State Board School topper of the Aditya Birla Group of Schools**. Ms. S. Hasini secured the second position with 98.2%, and Ms. Lekha Sri. secured third position with 96.8%.

2. Co-Curricular Activities:

This year, we optimized the allocation of co-curricular periods on Wednesdays and Saturdays, allowing students to engage in structured activities such as yoga and various inter-house and intramural competitions. For our youngest learners, we introduced age-appropriate competitions and activities that encourage teamwork and creativity.

Our students enthusiastically participated in various literary, cultural, visual, and performing art activities, honing their skills, fostering teamwork, and developing leadership qualities. To ensure each child's participation, we have a house system to conduct inter-house competitions throughout the year.

The academic year 2024-25, **Arun House** lifted the winner's trophy, winning the overall competitions, (Sports, games, Literary and Cultural activities all together) that is **Champion of Champions** while **Martand House** bagged the first runner-up trophy.

I would like to mention a few co-curricular achievements of our students at the district, state, and national levels:

SCIENCE: State-level Science quiz competition.

Master Guna N of Class X participated in the State-Level Quiz competition organized by CSIR-CECRI and JIGYASA at Karaikudi, Tamil Nadu. (A Central govt Organization)

Among many CBSE and State Board schools across the state, Master Guna N secured first place in the state-level Science quiz competition. He was honored with a cash award of Rs. 5,000 and certificates.

State-Level Karate Tournament

Master Naveen Kumar of Class IX secured second place, while Master Gokul and Master. Ryan of Class IX gained third place at the State-Level Karate Tournament held at Madurai.

Classical dance (Bharatanatyam).

Kumari. Oviya R of Class IX was honored with the prestigious **Kalai Ilamani** award for her exceptional talent in classical dance (Bharatanatyam). She was nominated at the state level and received this award from the District Collector. She was honored with a cash award of Rs. 3,000 and certificates.

Our junior group dance/girls' team /qualified for the final round and participated in the National-Level ABG Inter-School Dance Competition.

3. Infrastructural Development

1. Upgradation of Computer Lab with New LAN Connection

To enhance the technological learning experience, Local Area Network (LAN) connection has been established in the computer lab. This upgrade ensures smoother internet access and promotes digital education for students.

2. In-House Water Purification System

In a visionary move, our school management has taken the initiative to establish an in-house water purification system, freeing us from reliance on external water sources. This forward-thinking decision ensures a constant supply of clean and potable drinking water for our students and staff, while reinforcing the management's commitment to self-sufficiency, sustainability, and providing a healthy learning environment.

3. Library Upgradation

Our school management has initiated a comprehensive library upgradation project to create a modern and conducive learning space. The ongoing renovations include:

Addition of a digital library, providing access to e-books, online resources, and digital media. Installation of inbuilt cupboards for efficient storage and arrangement of books and resources. These enhancements demonstrate the management's commitment to providing a learning environment that supports academic excellence, innovation, and personal growth.

. New Sick Room

We are proud to announce the launch of a fully equipped sick room on our campus, prioritizing the health, well-being, and safety of our students. This dedicated space provides a comfortable and secure environment for students to rest and recover in case of illness or emergency, until their parents arrive.

4. Fostering Strong Parent-School Relationships.

We believe that a strong partnership between parents and teachers is crucial for student success. To foster this relationship, we provide regular opportunities for parent-teacher meetings (PTMs) and orientation programs for new parents.

To foster transparency and maintain strong parent-school connections, we prepare monthly reports detailing all school activities. These reports, complete with photos, are shared with parents and management to keep them informed and engaged with their children's educational journey. This initiative has successfully bridged the school-community relationship, creating a shared sense of accomplishment.

5. The pathway to Empowerment and Ensuring Student Well-being.

To equip our teachers to excel, we consistently enrich our staff through various workshops. Our teachers undergo an average of 5-6 training sessions per year, enhancing their professional development. These workshops focus on effective teaching strategies, competency frameworks, and curricular goals.

The well-being and safety of our students remain paramount. We have implemented comprehensive safety protocols and conducted training sessions on fire safety and first aid for senior students and staff. We also conducted mock drills to prepare for fire safety, natural calamities, and other emergencies.

To nurture students' artistic talents, we've introduced classical dance and keyboard music classes. These programs develop artistic expression, musical skills, and diverse forms of creative expression.

We provide remedial tutoring (5 hours/week) for classes III-IX to support individualized learning.

Additionally, we offer extra coaching sessions (2 hours) per day for class X students to prepare them for board exams.

Our theme-based assemblies educate students on various topics, including moral values, social issues, and academic concepts.

To enhance students' communication skills and language comprehension, we have introduced 'The Hindu' Student Edition for classes 3 to 9, distributing around 120 copies and asked to read during 3.30 pm to 3.50 pm. This initiative encourages students to build a strong vocabulary and broaden their understanding of current events.
