Upon the approval of the School Management Committee for the transition from the state board to the CBSE Board, the school began systematic preparations to align with the CBSE norms and standards. Our transformation is guided by one purpose; enriching the learning journey of every child.

Scholastic Achievement

The academic session witnessed remarkable performance across all classes. Our students demonstrated consistent progress, supported by innovative teaching methodologies and continuous assessments. Five of our students secured above 90% in SSLC board examination.

Diagnostic, Remedial & Enrichment

In our continued pursuit of academic excellence and support to the diverse learning needs of our students, special remedial sessions for students of classes IX and X began from June, 2025. These sessions were designed to provide additional support in key subjects where subjects may require further assistance to strengthen their understanding. These remedial classes aim to bridge learning gaps, reinforce critical concepts and equip students with the skills necessary for their academic advancement.

Guidance and Counselling

An orientation session for students and parents focusing at guiding students and parents on importance of career guidance, along with a brief on how the CAP Test is useful and beneficial to students for professional and personal growth was held in the school. After the CAP Test, the queries of each student were cleared via online session. Principal also conducted session for students and parents to share the information on identification of correct career.

SPORTS DEVELOPMENT & PHYSICAL WELL BEING

Physical fitness and sportsmanship are integral to our curriculum. Regular yoga and fitness sessions are incorporated in the school Time table. Every Wednesdays and Saturdays, yoga sessions are conducted by the Yoga trained teacher, Mrs Purva Kuvalekar.

INFRASTRUCTURE EXPANSION AND UPGRADATION

We continue to enhance our infrastructure to provide the best learning environment:

4. Construction of Pathways, Painting of school buildings, renovation of Wellness room, Strong room, Math lab, Sports room and Science lab added beauty to our school.
5. Twenty new desktops have been affixed in the Computer Lab. One printer cum scanner has been placed in the computer room.
5. The school is under surveillance of 36 CCTV cameras for the safety of our students and staff. Keeping in view the safety of our students and staff, new large LCD TV has been installed for clear viewing of all the nook and corners in the school.
6. Playground is further developed to facilitate games for little ones by installing slides and swings.
7. Toilets have been facilitated for CWSN students and railings have been installed at the ramp.
8. A new music system has been installed to enrich the overall ambience of school assemblies and programmes, ensuring a more vibrant and impactful presentation.
9. LED lights have been installed to illuminate the classes and our school proudly holds its name with ABG logo.
10. New books have been purchased for the school library. Teaching Aids and equipment have been displayed in the Math lab.

I must express my thanks to all the departments of Grasim Chemical unit for helping us in various ways for the smooth functioning of the school.

Aditya Birla Experiential Learning Initiative

In alignment with CBSE NCF guidelines, the school has introduced Aditya Experiential Curriculum to promote competency-based education. This approach focuses on activity-based and application-oriented learning, enabling students to develop conceptual clarity, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills.

The initiative has received positive feedback from parents, who have expressed satisfaction with the noticeable improvement in their children's engagement, confidence, and overall learning outcomes. Digital Transformation through ERP

We have introduced ERP software system which automates the daily activities such as worksheets, official SOPs, circulars, attendance and HPC/report cards. All teachers and parents were facilitated with the sufficient information in a series of workshops and sessions. ERP software connects parents, teachers, principal and management at same platform. I feel glad to state that many parents have already started using the application.

ENVIRONMENTAL INITIATIVES

On 5th June World Environment Day was celebrated in the school. A special assembly was conducted on the theme 'Beat Plastic Pollution'. Students and the staff took a pledge to make the planet a little greener and more sustainable planet. Mime presentation by students urged everyone to observe each day as an environment day. PTA

Cocurricular Engagement and Development

2. Audits are being conducted to ensure safety related to electricity and fire.
3. Safety equipment has been installed in the school at various points. An inspection by the fire authorities from the district fire department was held in the school. Monthly maintenance of fire extinguishers is done by the Grasim safety department to avoid any mishap.
4. Under leadership of Mr Bangera, a team from Fire & Safety dept, Grasim conducted a training session with demonstration on Fire & Safety for our students and teachers.
5. Evacuations Plans have been installed at various points in the school building.
6. Four of our teachers, Mrs Vasanti Naik, Neelam Waigankar, Mrs Purva Kuvalekar and Ms Jayalaxmi Harikantra underwent two day fire safety training sessions held at Mangalore.
7. Security Guard has been appointed at the school entrance gate. In and Out Register is maintained.
8. Safe Internet Day was celebrated wherein students drew posters and held a rally on the school campus to spread awareness of safe internet usage led by IT head Mrs Neelam Waingankar.

To promote safety and security awareness among students, poster making competition was organized by Grasim Industries Safety Department for students of class I to IX. Mr. Bangera from Safety department addressed the students, emphasizing the importance of safety.
